The Erosion Control Crew Leader will be responsible for the ASYCC Erosion Control Crew, which shall include, but is not limited to:

- Provide direct supervision to the crew
- Communicate directly and often with the ECC ECC Program Director
- Successfully implement site plans designed by the ECC ECC Program Director
- Administrative tasks directly related to the Erosion Control Crew: Payroll, mileage, weekly reporting to ECC ECC Program Director, etc.
- Be available Monday thru Friday 8:00 am to 4:30 pm with the potential for an occasional weekend day or week night.

Requirements/Qualifications:

- The Erosion Control Crew Leader shall be a full time or part time resident of Acton or Shapleigh;
- The Erosion Control Crew Leader shall have prior experience working with and/or for a Youth Conservation Corp;
- The Erosion Control Crew Leader shall have the ability and willingness to perform physical labor and work outside in varied weather conditions; and
- Possess the necessary communication, organizational, and management skills sufficient to lead a high school age crew, interact with the public, and work under the direction of the ECC ECC Program Director.
